Objectives and methods of cooperation:

"DA and LO have agreed that continued improvement of the corporate sector's competitiveness and employees' job satisfaction are prerequisites for the continued developement of enterprises and for promoting the welfare and security of their employees"



Cooperation Committees in larger enterprises

"In enterprises with more than 35 employees or more, day-to-day cooperation should be promoted and observed by a cooperation committee composed of representatives of mangement and employees"



Information and consultation

"Information should be given to individual employees as well as to groups of employees. The information should be given in time for viewpoints, ideas and suggestions from employees to be included in the decision-making process. Information is necessary to enable employees to influence their own job situation"



Information provided to the cooperation committee

"Efficient and successfull cooperation requires continuous information of the cooperation committee about the affairs and developement of the enterprise"

- it's financial position and future prospects
- employment prospects
- major changes and any proposed restructuring, e.g.
 the use of new technology in the production sysstems



Cooperation committees

"The cooperation committee shall determine the scope of the cooperartion between mangement and employees at all levels within thwe enterprise

It is the overall taks of the cooperation committee to promote cooperation within the enterprise for the benefit of the enterprise and the individual employee alike"
